Lecture Title	DYNAMEID Program: International academic and research collaborations
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Abstract **【English】**

The COVID-19 crisis has emphasized the need for distance learning. ASAIHL (Association of Southeast Asians Institutions of higher Learning) Has developed a program called "ASAIHL Mundus" within which several Master curricula are planned to be developed. The first one is the DYNAMEID program which stands for "Dynamic of Emerging and infectious Diseases". DYNAMEID is a distance learning hybrid curriculum conducted jointly by five partners: Mahidol University (Thailand), University Gadjah Mada (Indonesia), University Putra Malaysia (Malaysia), University of Warsaw (Poland), University of Montpellier (France). Each partner provides part of an original syllabus. Students will receive two official degrees from two universities of their choice within the consortium. Students will be supported by scholarships. Training at the Master level must be completed by joined international research training. To do so an International doctoral School based on co-supervision, international research projects and multiple degrees will also be developed.
